



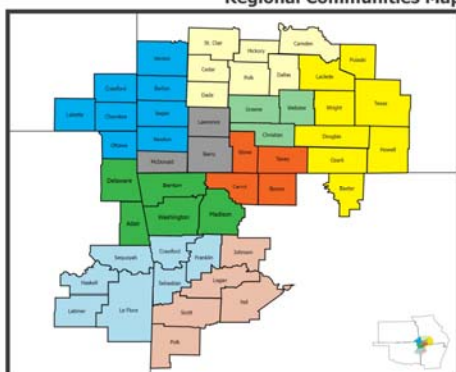

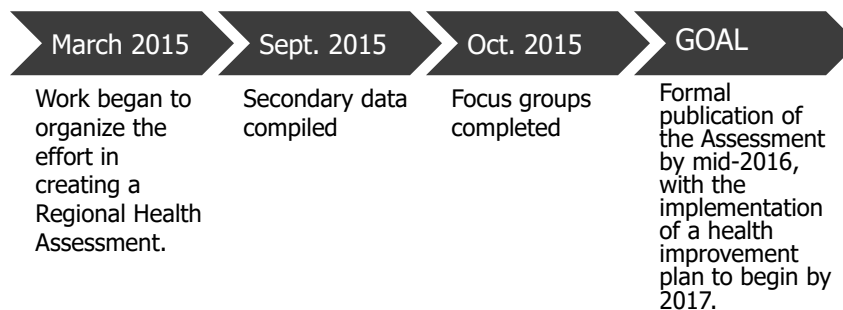


Regional Communities Map
